The West Virginia Association for Pupil Transportation wishes to invite you to participate in our 80th Annual State School Transportation Conference on July 21 - 24, at Oglebay Resort and Conference Center, Wheeling, West Virginia. Represented at the conference will be transportation directors, supervisors, mechanics, bus operators, and others from the State of West Virginia. You are encouraged to participate in this annual conference by displaying your equipment, school bus parts, supplies, etc. This a great opportunity to make new friends and business contacts.

All vendors who wish to exhibit their products must be registered. The registration fee, which includes some meals, is \$225.00 for each person with an exhibit. The exhibit fee for one space, approximately 4 x 8 feet, with one table and two chairs is \$225.00 with electric or \$200.00 without electric. If another table is desired, an additional \$200.00 will be charged. A product display in a hospitality room, or any equipment or vehicle displayed outside the Conference Center, will be considered an exhibit and subject to the exhibit fee. Exhibits and displays may be set up between 9:00 AM - 12:30 PM and 4:30 PM - 5:30 PM on Monday, July 21st and must be removed prior to 4:00 PM on Tuesday, July 22nd. Exhibits should be set up by 8:15 AM on Tuesday morning, July 22, 2025. The trade show will be open from 8:30 AM - 12:00 PM. Loading, unloading, security and/or handling of exhibits will the responsibility of the exhibitor. **Each exhibitor is responsible for all miscellaneous equipment, such as extension cords, monitor, etc., required to make your exhibit a success. If you do not bring these items with you, you may be**

charged a fee by Oglebay for their use. Each exhibit location will be assigned based on the size of the exhibit and special needs. Pre-registration of exhibitors must be received by Peggy Stone on or before July, 1, 2025. Registrations will be accepted after July 1 on a space available basis. Exhibit fee must be paid prior to setting up exhibits. Lodging reservations must be made by each vendor. Oglebay Resort will only be accepting reservations for the three night of lodging for the duration of the conference. One-night accommodations may be made at Hampton Inn Wheeling or SpringHill Suites Wheeling. Each are a 10-minute drive from the Conference Center.

If you wish to ship your materials for your exhibit ahead of your arrival, ship to:

Oglebay Park Resort will only receive shipments 10 days prior to the conference date.

This scholarship was established in memory of Jim Bailey, past Transportation Director of Roane County Schools, to help West Virginia students who attend post-secondary vocational and/or technical programs. Since the inception of this scholarship program in 1999, the number of students to receive assistance has grown from 1 to 12 annually and the amount of the scholarship has increased to \$600.00. The West Virginia Association for Pupil Transportation is able to provide these scholarships through fundraising events such as our annual auction to be held on Wednesday evening at our conference awards dinner. Again, this year, we will be conducting a silent and live auction. If you are unable to bring an item and you wish to make a monetary contribution, it would be greatly appreciated.
